



## **OFFICIAL STATEMENT RE CHANGE OF PRATITIONER**

As we have already informed many patients, there has recently been a change to the practitioner that will be carrying out bletharoplasty procedures here at Cosmetic Surgery at the Royal Liver Building.

We are aware that there has been discussion regarding the reason for this on social media and online forums, so feel it appropriate to now put out this statement to clarify our position.

Dr Sohraab Yadav has now left our practice. We were initially told that he would only be away temporarily due to a family matter. We have only very recently received confirmation that Dr Yadav will not, in fact, be returning to our practice.

For patients with upcoming procedures, we are able to offer surgery with Dr Aruna Dharmasena, a highly experienced surgeon. We have extended Dr Dharmasena's availability and opened additional operating lists to ensure patients can be accommodated without delay.

We are aware that there are patients who have paid for consultations and surgical procedures but who may not now wish to proceed. If that is the case, then please do get in touch with our team to ensure that you are refunded.

Based on the information currently available to us, we are currently unable to confirm Dr Yadav's ongoing availability for post-operative patient care but please rest assured, we will ensure that patient safety is not affected. We wish to make it clear that all patients will continue to receive appropriate continuity of care through our clinic. Any existing patient requiring review, follow up, or ongoing care can be seen promptly by one of our other experienced and trusted surgeons within the clinic.

As stated above we are aware of information currently being shared on blepharoplasty groups and online forums. We would like to clarify that all information provided to patients by our clinic has always been accurate and based on the information available to us at the time.

Any delay in communication has been necessary to ensure that all information has been appropriately verified prior to advising patients.

We understand that this situation may be concerning for some patients. Patient safety and continuity of care remain our highest priority. Affected patients will be contacted directly where appropriate to ensure timely review and ongoing management.

Our preference is you continue your care within our clinic, where we can ensure continuity and full clinical support throughout your treatment journey. However, should any patient wish to pursue alternative arrangements, we will assist, where appropriate, upon direct request.
